

Information Regarding the 2019 Quilt Show Registration Form

Categories:

1. Pieced: At least 80% of your quilt must be predominantly hand or machine pieced.
2. Appliquéd: At least 80% of your quilt must be hand or machine appliquéd.
3. Mixed: Your quilt is a significant mixture of many techniques such as, but not limited to, piecing, appliqué and hand or machine embroidery.
4. Wool: At least 60% of the quilt is made of wool appliqué or other techniques involving wool.
5. Art Quilt: Your quilt is an original exploration of a concept or idea rather than the handing down of a “pattern”. It experiments with textile manipulation, color, texture, and/or diversity of mixed media. An art quilt often pushes quilt world boundaries.
6. Modern Quilt: Your quilt has improvisational piecing inspired by modern design with bold colors, asymmetry, expansive negative space, and/or minimalism.
7. Challenge quilt directives are given to the membership by the committee chairperson.
8. Quilt made by a child: These are quilts made by a young relative of a guild member. Please note relationship to the guild member.
9. Miscellaneous: Table runners, totes, purses, placemats, etc.

Size:

The width plus length of your quilt will determine its size category.

140" or more	LARGE
100"-139"	MEDIUM
99" or less	SMALL

Example: a quilt that is 50" x 70" will be (50+70 = 120) in the Medium category. The Registration database will determine the size category based on the width and length you provide.

It is important to correctly enter the dimensions of your quilt. If your quilt is 50" x 70", and you enter 70 x 50, your quilt will hang sideways. The layout of how quilts are hung in the show is planned throughout the summer. Errors in your information are difficult to correct the night quilts are hung.

Check all the boxes that apply:

Please check the box if you would like to have your quilt judged by a Certified Judge. This year, the judge will leave you written comments about your quilt.

If you are within a group (such as a bee) that would like your quilts hung together, be sure to paper clip all the forms together and enter the name of a contact person for the group.

It is important to check the box(es) if you did your own machine or hand quilting.

Awards:

Three ribbons (1st, 2nd, and 3rd place) will be awarded for each size (large, medium, and small) in the categories Pieced, Appliquéd, and Mixed. Three ribbons will be awarded to each of the categories: Wool, Art, Modern, Challenge, and Miscellaneous. Additionally, three ribbons will be awarded to quilts Hand Quilted by the Entrant, three ribbons to quilts Longarm Machine Quilted by the Entrant, and three ribbons to quilts quilted on a stationary machine by the Entrant. Participation ribbons will be given to each entry by a child.
