

# Easy Accuquilt Christmas Stocking

(Unlined with faux cuff and hanger)

## CUTTING:

- From the main Fabric:
  - o Using the Accuquilt “Santa Stocking” die, cut two mirror image stocking feet.  
(Do not cut the cuff from the Accuquilt die).
- From a contrasting Fabric:
  - o Cut one cuff: 8” x 17”.
  - o Cut one hanger: 2” x 7”. (Or optionally, a 7” length of bias tape or ribbon.)

## CONSTRUCTION:

**Foot:** Place two stocking pieces right sides together with toe to the right. Using a 3/8” seam, stitch from the top to about 6” down on the toe side. Press the seam open at the top.

**Cuff:** Fold and press the 8” x 17” strip lengthwise, wrong sides together, to create a 4” x 17” cuff.

**Stocking:** Open the foot, right side up, toes facing each other. Center the cuff on the top of the foot. Align the top raw edges: pin in place. The cuff should extend beyond the foot portion on both sides. Sew a 3/8” seam joining the cuff to the foot.

Press the seam down toward the stocking foot; the cuff will be at the top of stocking.

Optionally, topstitch 1/8” below the seam.

If desired, topstitch or sew a decorative accent along the top of the cuff.

Place right sides of the stocking together, aligning the cuff seam lines (the top of the cuff will be aligned). Trim the extra cuff fabric at the back to create a straight line along the back of the stocking.

**Hanging Loop:** To construct the hanging loop from fabric, prepare the hanger by folding the strip in half wrong sides together lengthwise to 1” x 7”. Open and press long edges toward middle. Refold to create a 1/2”x 7” hanger. Topstitch 1/8” on both long edges.

Fold the hanging loop (fabric, tape, or ribbon) in half to create a 3 1/2” loop. Place the loop inside the cuff layers on the heel side, 1/2” from the top edge of the cuff. Match the raw edges. Pin in place.

**Finish Stocking:** Continue stitching the 3/8” seam around the stocking to join the remainder of the foot and cuff; back stitch across the hanger to strengthen it.

Reinforce the seam by sewing a second line of stitching, zig-zagging, or serging. Snip curves on the seam as needed, careful not to cut through stitching.

Turn stocking right side out. Press.
