

Supply List – 3D Fantastic Flowers

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General Supplies

- Basic Sewing supplies including pins and thread for piecing
- Sewing machine with zig zag/open toe foot
- Small cutting mat and rotary cutter
- Iron and Ironing Board (several for class to share if in-person)

Specific Supplies –

- 24-gauge Floral wire* and appropriate scissors for cutting wire
- Tools to assist turning fabric petals in-side out
- Fabric glue

Simple Flower applique pattern. Enlarge so petals are at least 2"x4". I will also provide several for use.

Background Fabric – solid piece or coordinating fabrics for background – approx. 12 ½ x 12 ½

Batting – piece 14x14; Backing fabric 14x14; Binding fabric

Flower Center Fabric– scrap approx. 5x5

Flower Petal Fabric – All the same or coordinating fabrics/scrap in flower color of your choice.

Note – petals are 2-sided. You will need fabric for both sides of the petal. Approx 2 Fat quarters

Stem (and Leaves optional) Fabric - Same or coordinating fabrics/scrap in leaf colors. Enough one stem (and 2-3 leaves optional) – approx. 1 Fat Quarter

Wonder Under fusible web or glue of your choice - Enough for under your stem and flower center (NOT necessary but very helpful)

Quilting Thread for Petals – match or contrasting

Quilting Thread for Leaves/Stem – match or contrasting

Quilting Thread for Background – match or contrasting

* Floral Wire usually at JoAnn Fabric, Hobby Lobby, Michael's Craft, on-line, etc. Examples include: 24-gauge Green Enamel Coiled Floral Wire \$3.99; 24-gauge Green Enamel – Easy Cut Floral Wire \$3.49; 24-gauge Green Enamel Annealed Floral Wire

Optional – Beads or sequins to embellish flower center; additional batting to create trapunto effect on flower center

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
