

Kathy Doughty Workshop: *Seeds and Stems*



Seeds and Stems Quilt: 60" x 70"

Option: Do it with my Seeds and Stems fabric collection or fabrics of your choice.

Skills: large scale cutting for blocks; appliqué using Wash Away paper.

It's a simple quilt with easily achieved results.

I should also mention that the pattern for this will be in Quiltmania's *Simply Modern* magazine in the spring.

Pattern: Seeds and Stems

Fabric requirements:

Seeds and Stems Fabrics

Backgrounds:

1 yd (90cm) of 2 light textured fabrics

2/3 yd (60cm) of 1 medium textured fabric

1/3 yd (30cm) of 3 large scale graphic prints

1 yd (90cm) of 3 large scale floral prints

1/3 yd (30cm) of stem fabric

2 yds (2m) Wash Away Applique Paper (water soluble paper for appliqué NOT embroidery)

2/3 yd (60cm) binding

It is not required that this project be done in the Seeds and Stems fabrics, and in fact it would be more fun if it was a mix of these with others. I talk a lot about selecting fabric in my class introduction.
