

Preemie Baby Fleece Caps

Great for using up fleece scraps. These caps are very easy to make and take no time at all.

Please remember the seams are meant to be on the OUTSIDE of the cap as seams irritate the babies fragile and sensitive skin.

1. Cut three (3) pieces of fleece, preferably with the "stretchy" sides on the horizontal.
2. Using a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam, sew pieces 1 and 2 together (*wrong sides together*) starting from the bottom and sewing to the top stopping $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top. Backstitch at both ends of seam.
3. Sew piece 3 to the other side of piece 2 (*wrong sides together*) starting from the bottom and sewing to the top stopping $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top. Backstitch at both ends of seam.
4. If desired, insert 3 fleece tassels (about 1" long by $\frac{3}{8}$ " wide) at the top. Sew piece 3 to the other side of piece 1, sewing over the tassels. Backstitch at both ends of seam.
5. Clip all threads.
6. Fold one seam up 1" and tack with 2-3 stitches.
