



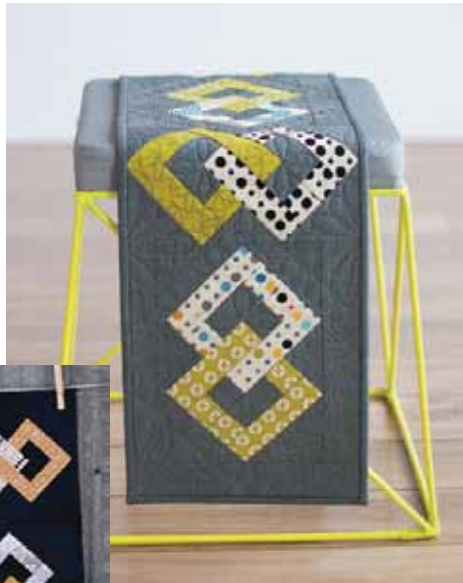

Stripology 2

Focus is on 2 different projects from the book **Stripology 2**, Using the Stripology ruler to cut your strips and scraps fast and efficiently:

Students learn the methods for both designs and have the opportunity to work on one or both in class.



Bring to Class:

Stripology 2 book (If you don't have it, I will be available to purchase in class). Sewing Machine, Scissors, thread for piecing, pins, seam ripper, cutting mat, rotary cutter, Stripology ruler (optional but will be available for purchase in class), smaller ruler like a 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" or similar.

Strip To Be Square Fabric Requirements

	Mini 15" x 15"	Runner 9-1/2" x 41"	Crib 26" x 38"
Assorted 1-1/2" x 15" strips	8 strips	10 strips	30 strips
Background	1/2 yd.	1/2 yd.	7/8 yd.
Binding	Fat Quarter	1/4 yd.	1/3 yd.
Backing	Fat Quarter	1/2 yd.	7/8 yd.

Strip To Be Square Cutting before class

Cut strips the full width of the fabric. If cutting from Fat Quarters or Fat 8's, cut from the longer side so your strips are about 21". Pattern is written based on 21" FQ /F8's or 42" wide fabrics.	Mini 15" x 15" 4 Blocks	Runner 9-1/2" x 41" 5 Blocks	Crib 26" x 38" 15 Blocks
Cut Background fabric into:			
1-1/2" wide strips Subcut into 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles Subcut into 1-1/2" squares	1 strip 8 rectangles 8 squares	1 strip 10 rectangles 10 squares	3 strips 30 rectangles 30 squares
4-1/4" wide strips Subcut into 4-1/4" squares then cut them twice diagonally into	1 strip 2 squares 8 triangles	1 strip 3 squares 12 triangles	1 strip 8 squares 32 triangles
4" wide strips Subcut into 4" squares then cut them once diagonally into	1 strip 8 squares 16 triangles	1 strip 10 squares 20 triangles	2 strips 30 squares 60 triangles
2" wide strips for sashing Subcut into 2" x 9-1/4" rectangles	2 strips 6 rectangles	2 strips 8 rectangles	5 strips 18 rectangles
Cut Binding fabric into:			
2-1/4" strips	4 strips	3 strips	4 strips

Assorted 1-1/2" x 14" strips	12 strips	30 strips	64 strips
1-1/2" x 21" strips for Block Centers	1 strip	3 strips	5 strips
Background	1/8 yd.	1/4 yd.	2/3 yd.
Binding	Fat Quarter	1/4 yd.	1/3 yd.
Backing	Fat Quarter	3/8 yd.	1 yd.
